

DIRECTIONS.

The cards having been dealt, each player selects from his hand all pairs of similar cards, and plays them to the centre of the table. Then, beginning on the left of the dealer, each player, in turn, draws a card from his right-hand neighbor, without seeing the face of the cards. If a match can be made with the card drawn, the pair are played; if not, the card is kept. This goes on till all the cards have been played except the Old Maid card, for which there is no match. The holder of that at the end is
